Driving Directions from Mittagong to Joadja Homestead and historic area

Cost: \$25 pp for 90 min tour, with commentary, in provided people movers: pay on day

OVERVIEW OF RUN: From Mittagong to Joadja - 30 mins (25 km)

Meet at 9:00am for 9:30 departure to Joadja. Arrival time at Joadja is 10:00am,

Morning tea - BYO or buy, 90min tour begins 11:00am in people mover vehicle \$25 pp

BYO picnic lunch - no alcohol - buy from licensed cafe. Bring your chairs, etc.

Shady trees available!! Tour and tasting of Distillery (walking distance). Depart for home.

By 9:00am for 9:30 departure: Assemble in carpark of the Mittagong Information Centre.

Turn left from Old Hume Highway (watch for driveway after the Best Western Hotel) into the carpark. It is well signposted. Facilities available. Morning Tea at Joadja - BYO or buy at kiosk.

## **Driving Directions, from the Mittagong Information Centre Carpark:**

Turn Left from the information carpark and move into the right lane

Stay in right lane where road divides. Follow signs to Berrima & Wombeyan Caves (Main St) Stay in right lane, following signs to Wombeyan Caves. Road is Old Hume Highway.

## **DO NOT EXIT** TO CANBERRA (M3)

Stay right and go over Freeway, continue about 5 minutes

Turn right onto Wombeyan Caves Road, continue about 5 mins

Turn left onto Greenhills Road (sign to Berrima-10 and Joadja-14)

Turn right onto Joadja Road. Drive through the beautiful countryside.

At the end of Joadja Road, look for a sign to the right saying "Joadja Heritage Tours and Whisky Distillery".

Turn right over the cattle grid and you are now 6 km from Joadja Gate.

Joadja is at the end of the road, which becomes an unsealed but good dirt road.

(there is a sealed section of curved, downhill road)

Go straight ahead, through the Joadja Gates (over a cattle grid) onto a graded, single lane driveway into Joadja carpark.

We will have morning tea, overlooking the peaceful countryside. The tour takes us into the hills, etc where the historic town and cottages are situated. Val will provide a commentary explaining the collection of shale and its uses and the history of the area.
